

GCSE External Examinations June 2012

To register candidates must come to the college in person before the appropriate deadline for entry to complete an application form.

Registration Opens 14th February 2012

There are four essentials required for registration, which are:

- 1. One ‘up to date’ photo** (passport size)
- 2. A valid, photographic form of ID** (e.g. Driving License/Passport)
- 3. UCI Number** (to be found on a previous results statement)
- 4. Subject/Unit codes for entry** (as appropriate to each level and board)

Please note that it is the candidate’s responsibility to ensure that the correct codes are used when registering to enter the exams.

It is advisable to ring the college prior to your visit if there are any doubts. Registration can take place between 9.30am and 1:00 pm, Monday – Friday.

Fees:

There is a ‘one off’ administration fee of £165 (non-refundable) in addition to the following: -

GCSE subject - £92 (or £20 per module if entering modular subjects)
IGCSE subject - £115

All the above charges rise for late entries.

Supplements: - All modern foreign languages - £55 per oral exam

It is not usually possible to perform any science experimental coursework in the college.

Method of Payments

Full payment should be made at the time of application when visiting the college. Payment can be by cash or cheque, but not card. If you have any further questions, please contact the college.
